I. Competition terms specified by the Selection Board:

Candidates entering the competition have to meet the requirements specified in the Act on Higher Education from 20 June 2018 (*Journal od Laws from 2020, heading 85 consolidated text as amended*) Article 113 and they must be compliant with the following criteria:

1. PhD in , biological, medical, chemical or related sciences;
2. documented experience in molecular biology, cell biology and molecular genetics of animals;
3. excellent research track record documented by authorship of publications in leading scientific journals;
4. priority will be given to candidates with international research practice experience in the field of human molecular genetics or developmental biology of animals;
5. basic knowledge in bioinformatics and biostatistics;
6. experience in animal cell culture and *in vivo* approaches is advantageous, but not essential;
7. priority will be given to candidates experienced in fluorescence and confocal microscopy;
8. excellent command in Polish and English, spoken and written.

II. Documents required:

1. application letter;
2. curriculum vitae;
3. consent to the processing of one's personal data:

 - complete list of publications,
 - list of research projects participation,
 - list of trainings and workshops participation.

Verification will be carried out based both on an interview with candidates and submitted documents. If it is necessary selection board will appoint reviewers of scientific achievements or ask candidate to conduct lessons with students.

Information clause for candidates

In accordance with Article 13 of the General regulation on the protection of personal Data of 27 April 2016 (Official Journal of the European Union L 119 of 04.05.2016), I hereby inform that:
