As a research technician you will work with a team of researchers and carry out experiments.

The position is funded by NCN SONATA BIS 2018/30/E/NZ1/00073 full-time, initially for 9 months.

Salary: 85.000 PLN/year gross pay p.a. (brutto brutto).

Tasks:

Conducting molecular biology and cell culture experiments, recording and analyzing experimental data, drawing preliminary conclusions, keeping detailed records of experimental work, writing and revision of scientific protocols.

Necessary: Bachelor's, Master's or PhD degree in biology or related life science field, laboratory experience. Background in basic molecular biology techniques. Enthusiasm toward new techniques, strong communication skills and team spirit. Fluency in English and Polish.
